MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

MEMBERSHIP

We have memberships available. The initial cost to purchase a family membership is \$450. The annual dues for a family membership are \$400. If you know of anyone who is interested in joining that is residing in the membership area, have them contact Natalie Spray. The membership area includes Deer Forest, Deer Run, Keeneland, and Buckingham.

Single Memberships are also available. The annual dues are \$240. Single memberships are for a single person household within the membership area and the children of existing members who are over the age of 23 and living with the member. The initial cost to purchase a single membership is \$450. The cost is the same because the membership is convertible to a family membership. The initial cost will be waived if the membership is purchased in the spring after the member turns 23.

If you plan to transfer your membership, the new family needs to be in the membership area as stated in the guidelines. A letter of transfer must be sent to Natalie Spray. The letter must include who the membership should be transferred to, their address and phone number. Also, the letter must state a date to transfer and be signed by the member transferring. A check for \$25 to transfer the membership must be attached to the letter of transfer. The transfer must be approved by the board.

POOL SCHEDULE & HOURS

The pool rules are enclosed. Please read and review the rules with your children. USA Pools will be managing the pool and hiring lifeguards for this summer swim season. The pool will open on Friday, May 25th at 4:00 P.M.

Hours of Operation:

Sunday—Thursday 12:00 P.M.—9:00 P.M.

Friday & Saturday 12:00 P.M.—10:00 P.M.

Remember the pool closes at 6:00 P.M. on nights of home swim meets. Home meets are scheduled for Thursday, June 14th, Monday, June 18th, and Thursday, June 21st. A reminder will be posted on these days.

Once school resumes on Monday, July 30, the pool will open at 4:00 P.M., Monday—Friday. Weekend hours and closing hours

will remain the same. The pool will close for the summer season on Sunday, September 17th.

Guest rules: Residents of the membership area (Deer Forest, Deer Run, Keeneland, and Buckingham) who are not DRRC members are not allowed as pool guests. Out-of-town or overnight guests from outside of Rockdale, Newton, Henry, DeKalb, and Gwinnett counties are allowed as guests free of charge. A fee of \$4 per person is due at sign-in for all other guests. Please voluntarily pay all applicable guest fees. Do not put yourself, your guest, or the lifeguards in an uncomfortable position by ignoring the guest rules. Remember to be prepared to show photo identification for the first few weeks until the lifeguards learn names and faces.
